#### **COMPOST FACILITY**

The compost facility, located on Aviation Way beside the Wastewater Treatment Plant, is open to all Residents of Highspire only, every Wednesday from 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m., except for holidays, non-residents and commercial entities will not have access to this facility. A permit is required and can be purchased at the Borough Office during regular business hours. The fees are as follows: \$20.00 per year and \$25.00 per load for curbside pickup for permit holders only. All fees are required to be paid in advance. Residents must show their permit, photo ID and proof of address during drop off.

#### CODES/ZONING

Building and Zoning Permits are required for numerous things including new roofs, electrical service upgrades, decks, additions, fences, storage sheds, garages, swimming pools, and a multitude of other things. New floor coverings, painting, and minor repairs do not require permits. Please call the Borough Office at 717-939-3303 if you need any additional information.

As Spring time approaches here are some Borough facts that all residents should be aware of . . . The Borough's Code states that grass and weeds are not to exceed eight inches in height. Don't forget to mow the grass areas between the sidewalks and curbs. Also, sweep sidewalks and cut weeds. Do not blow grass onto streets. Rubbish is not permitted to accumulate on or around properties. Rubbish includes, but is not limited to paper, rags, cartons, wood, metals, plastics and other items.

#### **POLICE DEPARTMENT NEWS**

#### **Storage of Motor Vehicles**

A vehicle is considered abandoned, even if it is parked on your property, when the vehicle registration and/or inspection has expired and/or if the vehicle is inoperable or damaged, however; an owner may obtain a permit to store the vehicle for six (6) months from the Code & Zoning Office for a fee of \$45.00.

#### **Parking of Boats and Trailers**

State law and Borough Ordinances prohibits any person or owner to park, or allow to remain parked, on any street within the Borough (including state highways), any boat, boat upon a trailer, cart, trailer or towed vehicle for a period exceeding fortyeight (48) hours according to state law provisions.

#### **DOG LICENSING**

Licensing dogs over the age of three months in Pennsylvania is mandated by state law. Those who do not comply can receive fines up to \$300 for each violation of the law.

All dogs must be under control. This means that when your dog is not on your property, it must be under the direct control of you or the handler.

The best way to control your dog is with a leash. Pet owners are also responsible for cleaning up after their pets. This could be on pubic property when out walking or in your own backyard. Please be responsible for your pet.
