ORDINANCE NO. 654 of 2024

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF HIGHSPIRE, DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 15 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
THE BOROUGH OF HIGHSPIRE, PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL
OF A HANDICAPPED-ONLY PARKING SPACE AND THE
ESTABLISHMENT OF A NEW HANDICAPPED-ONLY PARKING
SPACE AT 640 ESHELMAN STREET HIGHSPIRE, PA.**

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Highspire, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows, to wit:

Section One

Chapter 15, Part 3, Section §305 of the Codified Ordinances of the Borough of Highspire is hereby amended by the removal of a handicapped-only parking space located along the west side of the Highspire Municipal Building, 640 Eshelman Street, off of Cherry Avenue, and adding the following location where parking shall be limited to vehicles displaying handicapped driver or passenger permits:

Eshelman Street @ Poplar Avenue	North	640	One Standard Parking Space

Said handicap only parking space shall be valid indefinitely.

Section Two

Any ordinance or part thereof in conflict with the provisions hereof is hereby repealed except that nothing in this ordinance shall affect any act done or liability incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending or to be instituted under any repealed or superseded ordinance.
